BUILDING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION AND ADDITIONS

Current Codes: 2021 IRC; 2021 NMRBC; 2018 ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE;

Incomplete applications are not accepted.

- 1. Residential: One (1) bound sets of plans drawn to 1/4" = 1.0 foot to include the following:
 - Site plan drawing showing building setback, on-lot ponding and dimensions
 - Foundation plan with details/single story or multi-story
 - Floor plan showing room uses and dimensions
 - Building elevations details to include height dimensions
 - Cross sections of walls
 - Roof and floor framing plan
 - Electrical plan to include meter, condenser location, one line diagram and load calculations
 - Copy of truss layout and design from manufacturer
 - 2018 REScheck

*Homeowner permits require completion of "Instructions for Permit" and "Responsibilities and Liabilities Acknowledgement"

- 2. Property Record Card Copy can be obtained at County Assessor's Office Room 220
- 3. Recorded proof of Ownership (Warranty Deed or Real Estate Contract)

Copy can be obtained at County Clerk's Office - Room 200.

4. Septic Tank or Sewer Service (Utility Bills not accepted)

For septic tank, bring in a copy of septic tank permit from NMED (575)288-2050 ** OR **

For sewer service, bring in a ready, willing and able letter from sewer provider

5. Proof of Water Service (Utility Bills not accepted)

For domestic well, bring in a copy of the well permit from State Engineer's Office (575)524-6161

** OR **

For water service, bring in a ready, willing and able letter from water provider

- 6. ENGINEERING REQUIREMENTS:
 - 1. **SWPPP and NOI:** Required for (1) All projects located in a subdivision; or (2) Outside a subdivision when the parcel exceeds one acre.
 - 2. **DRIVEWAY PERMIT:** If accessing a county road a driveway permit will be required, (\$20.00). If accessing a state road a permit from NMDOT may be required. Please verify with DAC Engineering Department for specific requirements or questions (575) 525-6164
- 7. Electrical, Plumbing, and Mechanical permits are obtained AFTER issuance of the building permit by the licensed tradesman at the Building Inspections Office.
